Temporary architecture - Horse shelter

The project is a collaboration between different agencies Politecnico di Milano, the House of Charity and the Prison of Bollate.

It therefore intends to undertake a stable that is managed by the prisoners. The site on which insists the project is located in the vicinity of the prison, at Cascina Triulza.

The project counts 5 boxes for the housing of horses with its paddocks, a building used as a tack and feed room, a shed for washing horses, a building used as a reception and offices, a canopy or pergola for organizing parties and events, a riding school for the training of horses and a paddock where the horses are left to pasture. Goal is to give life to a project designed for the self-construction with simple technologies and building materials. The paddock is infact designed to use the tires as building material, filled in their interior with soil or concrete and reinforced with metal vertical elements.
